# A-Z Fundraising ideas



Abseil: Organise a sponsored abseil for thrill-seekers looking to raise money.

Auction: Host an auction where people can bid on items or experiences.

Afternoon Tea: Invite supporters to a classic afternoon tea, with donations going to charity.



Bake Sale: Sell delicious homemade cakes and pastries for a great cause.

Bingo: Host a fun bingo night with prizes to be won.

Dinner Party: A fancy dinner with guests donating to attend.

Disco/Dance: Organise a dance party with a fun theme to raise funds.

Darts Match: Set up a charity darts tournament at a local pub or community centre.

Coffee Morning: Invite people to come along for coffee, cake, and donations.

Cinema Screening: Organise a charity movie night in a local cinema or community hall.

Car Boot Sale: Encourage supporters to sell unwanted items, with proceeds going to charity.



Face Painting Competition: Host a face-painting contest with proceeds going to charity.

Football Match: Organise a charity football game, either for fun or with local teams.

Fancy Dress Day: Encourage people to come to school or work in fancy dress for donations.

Easter Egg Hunt: Host a family-friendly Easter egg hunt for donations.

Easter Party: Celebrate with an Easter-themed party filled with activities and games.



Games Night: Organise a board game, video game, or card game night for charity.

Girls' Night In: Host a cosy evening in with friends, all while raising money for a cause.

Give It Up: Get sponsored to give up something, like chocolate or coffee, for a set time.

International Evening/Day: Celebrate different cultures with food, music, and fundraising activities.

It's a Knockout: Organize a fun obstacle course challenge for teams.

Irish Night: Celebrate Irish culture with music, dancing, and fundraising.

Karaoke Night: A fun-filled karaoke evening where participants donate to sing.

Knitting for Charity: Organize a knitting group where items are made to sell for charity.



Ladies Night: Host a women-only event for a fun evening while raising money.

Luncheon: Organize a fundraising lunch with delicious food and donations.

Leap Year Challenge: Use that extra day in February to hold a special fundraising event.

Head Shave: Brave fundraisers can shave their heads to raise awareness and money.  
Halloween Party: Host a spooky Halloween event with all proceeds going to charity.

Jewellery Collection: Gather unwanted jewellery to sell or auction for charity.  
Jazz Night: Host a jazz-themed music evening to raise money.  
James Bond Night: Organize a glamorous, Bond-themed casino night or party.

Marathon Events: Participants can get sponsored to complete marathons, whether running, cycling, or swimming.  
Matched Giving: Partner with businesses to match the donations raised.  
Music & Mulled Wine Evening: A cosy evening with live music and mulled wine.

Murder Mystery Night – Create a themed event where attendees solve a fictional crime.

Magic Show – Hire a magician and sell tickets to an enchanting evening.

Mile Challenge – Participants complete a set number of miles running, cycling, or swimming for sponsorships.

Name the...: Hold a competition to name a pet, toy, or mascot, with entry donations.

New Year's Eve Party: Celebrate the start of the new year with a fundraising party.

Pamper Day: Treat supporters to a day of relaxation and pampering while raising funds.

Purple Day: Celebrate this awareness day by encouraging people to wear purple and donate.

Pancake Race: Organize a pancake-flipping race on Pancake Day to raise money.

Quiz Night: A classic quiz night with entry fees going to charity.

Quintessentially British Event: Host a fundraising event with all things British, like afternoon tea and cricket.

Strictly Challenge: Host a dance competition in the style of "Strictly Come Dancing."

Skydiving: For the adventurous, organize a sponsored skydive to raise money.



Office Collection: Place donation boxes in offices and encourage people to contribute.

Open Garden Day: Invite the public to visit private gardens for a small donation.

Obstacle Course: Organize a fun and challenging obstacle course event.



Raffle: Sell raffle tickets for a chance to win prizes.

Running Events: Organize a charity run, whether it's a 5k, 10k, or a marathon.

Tea Party: A traditional tea party where attendees donate to the cause.

Tug of War: Organize a tug of war competition for teams to compete and raise money.

Tuck Shop: Set up a tuck shop selling sweets and snacks, with profits going to charity.

Uniform-Free Day: Let people pay to dress casually instead of wearing uniforms for a day.

University Challenge: Hold a quiz night inspired by the famous TV show.

Walkathon: Get people sponsored to take part in a long walk for charity.

Wax It: Participants get sponsored to endure a waxing session for charity.

Wear It: Have a themed dress-up day where participants donate to take part.

X-Factor Competition: Host a talent show inspired by the famous competition.
